Strongest evidence

1. Tesla emphasized varying electrostatic force in a medium

He then states that this force causes displacement of electricity and gives rise to currents. This is extremely important because the cause is not “current” first; the current is secondary to the electrostatic field condition.

In SVP-CMC language:

condition precedes motion.

2. He worked without ordinary return circuits

Tesla explicitly presents effects “without any return circuit” and challenges the old idea that current must circulate only in a closed conducting path. 3. He treated the earth and atmosphere as a giant condenser

That is one of the clearest “scalar potential” passages in functional terms. He is not talking merely about radiating transverse radio waves through empty space. He is talking about establishing **potential differences in the earth-atmosphere system.**

Tesla describes the Magnifying Transmitter as a grounded antenna circuit with tremendous electromagnetic momentum, low damping, and conditions arranged so that an immense accumulation of electrical energy could occur.

That is very close to our idea of **accumulating scalar potential at a center** before releasing it kinetically.

5. Tesla openly discussed “energy from the medium”

In *The Problem of Increasing Human Energy*, Tesla has sections titled “Energy from the Medium” and “Possibility of a Self-Acting Engine... Deriving Energy from the Medium.” He discusses wind, solar, terrestrial heat, atmospheric electricity, and other natural sources, but he also clearly pushes toward a more general idea: machinery drawing from the surrounding medium rather than consuming internal fuel.

This should be handled carefully. He was not necessarily saying “vacuum scalar energy” in the later Bearden sense. But he was looking for methods to draw usable power from an ambient energetic condition.

That is squarely aligned with the SVP-CMC inquiry.

6. Tesla used “longitudinal pulses in the ether”
